Summary of key messages and assurance:

Although the Board was not quorate on this occasion, the meeting continued without decision-making:

- **Integrated Governance Report (IGR)**

- The report summarised performance, successes, and issues in the Joint Venture services. It reflected information which is currently reported to the Clinical Operational Board in CCS and the Performance Review Executive in CPFT (Cambridgeshire & Peterborough NHS Foundation Trust). The reporting period for the IGR reviewed was January-March 2024.
- Performance against Healthy Child Programme mandated contacts has been mixed, with a focus on improving ante-natal contact performance as a key objective of the Annual Development Plan. Vacancies have impacted on performance against other contacts but performance against the 2.5 year face-to-face contact has stabilised.
- Collaborative working with Child and Family Centres has continued to spread under the Family Hubs programme, and the parent-infant relationship team in Peterborough has now been established. Implementation of the 0-5 pathway revised skill mix model continues. All of these innovations are being evaluated to inform future service development planning.
- Recruitment is underway for the January 2025 intake of the Specialist Community and Public Health Nursing programme. This will be a critical aspect of addressing the ongoing vacancy challenges across Cambridgeshire and Peterborough.
- There were no risks or new escalation points for escalation this reporting period.
