Purpose:

The revised CQC Statement of Purpose (V15) approved by the Board in September reflected the move of two registered locations namely Trust Head Quarters to Units 7 & 8 Meadow Park in October and the Wisbech Dental Access Centre to the newly refurbished Rowan Lodge on the North Cambridgeshire Hospital site in September.

It also reflected the discontinuation of out of hours provision across our Dental services, however since the meeting; we have agreed to continue providing this service in Peterborough for a further 2 months due to issues with mobilization for the new provider. We continue to work with commissioners to ensure an effective transfer.
