

## Participants with Intellectual Disability wanted for research



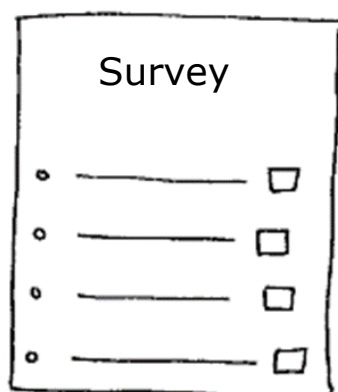
### Do you use the internet?
